



Monthly Meeting Minutes

July 19, 2017

- 1) Meeting brought to order at 7:40 pm by Jennie Zakrzewski
 - a) Review May and June 2017 Meeting Minutes – Motion to approve minutes. Minutes approved.

 - c) Presidents Report – No report
- 2) Secretary Report (Jillian Woodcock) – Have calculations for the head tax. Since all the sports are not present, will email the calculations out so they can be voted on next meeting.
- 3) Treasurer's Report (Laura Prouty) – Basketball – no activity. Baseball/Softball – paid all umpires. Received \$1,000 grant from State Farm. Insurance still needs to be allocated and will receive some cash from other sports so balance looks lower that it should be. Baseball All-star uniforms were paid for. Received a bill from the school for gym use. Not sure if it is for softball or basketball. It was for use in March and April. Softball was over by March so it should be basketballs. Cheerleading – fit kits are paid for. After they are mailed back, will receive a refund. Received deposits from SI Play and registrations fees. Football – wrote check for Riddell and received 3 or 4 checks for program fees. Operating – No activity. Soccer – wrote check for bus tour to city for soccer game. Wrestling – no activity. Will get on the insurance allocations.
- 4) Communications Director Report (Kara Schultz) – Nothing to report.
- 5) Commissioner Reports
 - a) Soccer (Melissa Winchell-absent) – Nothing to report
 - b) Football (Brian McGarrahan and Bart Early) – Gearing up for the season. July 31st practice was in full swing. Have not found commissioner replacements yet, but coaches are all set. Juniors have 21 kids and seniors have 24 kids. Flag has 21 kids and are in the NYFL this year so they will be traveling. The downside to that is they have to start practicing earlier. This year, we only have the turf for practice until August 13th.
 - c) Cheerleading (Katie Garmley) – 31 girls are signed up. 14 seniors, 7 juniors and 10 flag. Uniforms are ordered and will have fundraiser in order to help pay for the uniforms by the 1st practice. 3 girls have requested scholarships. What is the protocol for that? Usually ask for them to put in a little extra volunteering.
 - d) Baseball (Jack Sullivan-absent and Ernie LaBounty) – Was the letter sent to Stewart's for the ice cream party? Just wanted to follow up on that with Dave. All stars are over with. There was a lot of rain this season which made things tough.
 - e) Softball (Mike Bodnar-absent) – Emailed report. The 8U and 10U All Star teams concluded their seasons last week in the South Glens Falls Tournament. The 10U team finished in 3rd place in the tournament. The 10U team previously finished in 1st place in the Argyle tournament, while the 8U team finished in 2nd place in Argyle. Mike has reached out to several coaches regarding offering some sort of Fall Ball program. While the Fall Ball program does not have to be done through the OSAA, Mike would like to find a way to provide the girls who are interested in playing additional softball an opportunity to do so.

6) Old Business:

Advertising space – We are still open on how much to charge. Kara looked at other websites like South Glens Falls. They have links to logos. How do we advertise for it? Letters and applications. Baseball/Softball has different levels of sponsorships.

CPR classes – Greenwich fire will offer classes to any size group for the cost of the card which is \$10 per card. They will teach as small as 3 to 6 people in a class. 1st aide is a 6 hour course that is taught in a 8 hour day. They would actually charge only what the cards cost.

7) New Business:

The Cardboard races at Hudson Crossing Park are coming up soon (August 12th). Ernie mentioned possibly setting up a table to do some OSAA advertising.

Wrestling – Ernie reached out to see if a few people were interested in helping with the wrestling program. Sarah Anderson and Todd Lewis showed up to talk with the board and see what was going on.

Sarah stated that she wrestled and had a good experience. Need to get kids involved in the program. Team uniforms are need to help with unity and have to keep it fund for the kids so that they become and stay interested in the sport. She has a wonderful person to ask for pointers and tips from.

Board members gave a list of things that need to be figured out such as an amount that is feasible to charge to be in the program (wrestling going into the off season can be expensive), insurance and the logistics of it (is NYWAY the way to go? NYWAY is only good for NYWAY sanctioned events), and a budget needs to be put together (how much would it take to run a wrestling program). Board mentioned about prior year and not knowing how many were registered, etc. and that there is nothing to hand off, that there is no template to follow. The Board is for feedback and support.

There was mention of combining with Greenwich youth wrestling program.
